

Cotton Fields

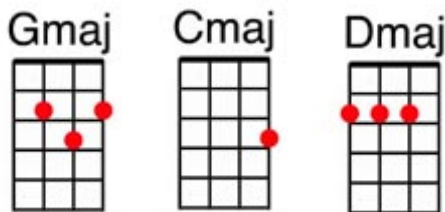
When I (G) was a little bitty baby
